
Climates on an Imaginary Continent

Base your answers to questions 6 through 10 on the map below. The map shows an imaginary continent on Earth. Arrows represent prevailing wind directions. Letters A through H represent locations on the continent. All locations are at sea level.



- 1. Explain why location A has a cooler, more humid climate than location B.
- 2. The climate at location C is much drier than at location D. Explain this difference in precipitation.

3. Which location would have the lowest average temperature for the year? Explain your answer.

- 4. How will the yearly temperature range of location E compare to the yearly temperature range of location F? Explain your answer.
- 5. How do the ocean currents influence the temperature of location G?
